

An eVisa for Kenya is not a traditional visa stamped into your passport. Authorisation to enter Kenya will be issued electronically.

CIBTvisas will email this authorisation to you in approximately 3 working days. You will need to present this authorisation to Kenya Immigration on arrival.

E-visas are valid for 90 days from the date of issue and allow a single entry, with up to 90 days stay for business and tourist visas, and a maximum 3 days stay for transit passengers.
